## HAYCOCK TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE No. 5

An Ordinance prohibiting the dumping or accumulation of refuse in the Township of Haycock and the establishment or maintenance of public or private dumps within said Township, and prescribing penalties for violation.

The Township of Haycock hereby ordains as follows:

- 1. "Refuse" is all discarded articles or materials, except human sewage, animal manure, animal and vegetable matter, and other articles and materials ordinarily used for food.
- 2. No person, association, firm or corporation shall keep or suffer to remain upon his or her premises, or on any private property, any refuse matter, or cast the same upon any lot or piece of ground within Haycock Township, or upon the shores or margin of any stream or body of water, or upon the highways in said Township.
- 3. No person, association, firm or corporation shall use or permit to be used, any spot or place within the Township as a public or private dump for refuse matter.
- 4. Any person, firm or corporation who or which shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance shall upon summary conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of \$25.00 and costs of prosecution, and, in default thereof, to imprisonment for not more than ten days, provided each day's continuance of a violation shall constitute a separate offense.
