

ORDINANCE NO. 21

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING STOP INTERSECTIONS WITHIN  
THE TOWNSHIP OF HAYCOCK, COUNTY OF BUCKS AND STATE  
OF PENNSYLVANIA

The Township of Haycock hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION I. The following intersections are hereby designated as stop intersections, and official stop signs shall be erected at such intersections and placed so as to confront traffic approaching on the first named road or street travelling in the direction indicated. It shall be unlawful for the driver or operator of any vehicle, street car, or trackless trolley omnibus, to fail to come to a full stop, within a reasonable distance, before entering the intersection, after the erection of said official stop signs.

(a) Eastbound traffic on Township Road No. 467 (Raudenbush Road) shall stop at its intersection with Township Road No. 404 (Mission Road).

(b) Eastbound traffic on Township Road No. 465 (Thatcher Road) shall stop at its intersection with Township Road No. 404 (Mission Road).

(c) Southbound traffic on Township Road No. 390 (Creamery Road) shall stop at its intersection with Township Road No. 398 (Old Applebachsville Road).

(d) Westbound traffic on Ceider Press Lane shall stop at its westbound terminus, its intersection with Old Applebachsville Road.

SECTION II. Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall suffer the penalties imposed by the Vehicle Code of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania now provided or as may, at any time hereafter, may be amended in respect thereto, together with the costs of prosecution, in default of which payment the defendant shall be sent to the Bucks County Prison for a period not to exceed 60 days in accordance with the Act of June 19, 1961 P.L. 486, § 1; (as amended by the Act of June 6, 1965, P.L. 73, § 1) 53 P.S. § 65741.
