

ORDINANCE NO. 22

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE OPERATION OF CERTAIN
MOTOR VEHICLES UPON CERTAIN STREETS, ROADS, OR
HIGHWAYS AND IMPOSING RESTRICTIONS AS TO THE
WEIGHT OF VEHICLES PERMITTED TO BE SO OPERATED
WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP OF HAYCOCK, BUCKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

WHEREAS the Supervisors of Haycock Township, a second
class township, in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, has determined
that deterioration is occurring to Cider Press Lane; and

WHEREAS said Supervisors have determined that said Cider
Press Lane may be seriously damaged or destroyed unless the use of
same by vehicles, ~~trucks, and other motor vehicles or machinery~~
thereon is prohibited or the permissible weight thereof be reduced;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Township of Haycock hereby ordains
as follows:

SECTION I. The use of Cider Press Lane is restricted
in that no trucks shall be permitted to use same and all trucks
are prohibited from using same, except for local deliveries, and,
in all events, there shall be a weight limit of ~~two~~^{FOUR} tons applicable
to all such trucks or other motor vehicles when using, attempting
to use, crossing over or upon Cider Press Lane in Haycock Township
or any part thereof. Said weight limitation shall mean and be
interpreted to mean the gross weight of the vehicle and its contents.
Official signs as so designated by the Pennsylvania Department of
Transportation or the Pennsylvania Department of Highways shall be
erected and maintained immediately in advance of each terminus of
Cider Press Lane and upon the right-hand side of Cider Press Lane
not more than twenty-five (25) feet beyond any intersected road on
which the restriction does not apply. A sign "NO TRUCKS" shall be
placed upon a pole and immediately thereunder a sign "EXCEPT LOCAL
DELIVERIES" shall be placed upon said pole immediately beneath the

"NO TRUCK" sign. If possible, a sign "WEIGHT LIMIT 4 TONS" shall be placed immediately under the two aforesaid signs. If not possible to so place the latter sign, said sign "WEIGHT LIMIT 4 TONS" shall be placed on a separate pole twenty-five (25) feet beyond the pole containing the signs "NO TRUCKS" and "EXCEPT LOCAL DELIVERIES".

SECTION II. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon summary conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00), together with the costs of prosecution, and, in default of the payment thereof, shall undergo imprisonment in the Bucks County Prison for not more than five (5) days.

SECTION III. EFFECTIVE DATE: This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its enactment and ordination and shall be enforceable immediately upon the erection and maintenance of said official signs hereinabove referred to.
