

ORDINANCE NO. 60

AN ORDINANCE SETTING THE SPEED LIMIT FOR
MOTOR VEHICLES ON HAYCOCK RUN ROAD, FROM
TOP ROCK TRAIL ROAD TO THE TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY
LINE WITH NOCKAMIXON TOWNSHIP

Preamble

The Haycock Township Board of Supervisors, upon the recommendation of the Township Engineer and the Township Roadmaster, and pursuant to appropriate engineering and traffic studies, hereby enacts and ordains as follows:

ARTICLE I

Words and phrases when used in this Ordinance shall have the meaning described to them in the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code, 1976, June 17, P.L. 162, Act No. 81, as amended.

ARTICLE II

It shall be unlawful for any person to drive a motor vehicle in excess of thirty-five (35) miles per hour on Haycock Run Road (T.R. 424), from its intersection with Top Rock Trail Road (T.R. 422) to the Haycock Township boundary line at Haycock Run Creek.

ARTICLE III

The proper authorities of the Township are directed to erect official signs establishing the speed on Haycock Run Road at thirty-five (35) miles per hour, and to do so in conformity with the provisions of the Vehicle Code.

ARTICLE IV

Any person who violates any provision of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of Thirty-Five Dollars (\$35.00). Any person exceeding the maximum speed limit by more than five (5) miles per hour shall pay an additional fine of Two Dollars (\$2.00) per mile for each mile in excess of five (5) miles per hour over the maximum speed limit.

ARTICLE V


All ordinances, parts of ordinances, and amendments thereof are ~~appealed~~ insofar as they are inconsistent with this Ordinance.
